What do I need to apply?

Additional fields may include:

- Date of business establishment
- Description of Economic Impact Loss (loss of sales or revenue)
- Number of employees on March 1 (2-25) \$5,000 - \$25,000
- Number of employees working remotely as a result of the disaster
- Estimated loss of revenues March 15, 2020 - April 15, 2020
- Description of how funds will be utilized to maintain operations or reopen after the disaster

What do I need to apply?

Additional fields may include:

- Date of business establishment
- Description of Economic Impact Loss (loss of sales or revenue)
- Estimated loss of revenues March 15, 2020 - April 15, 2020
- Description of how funds will be utilized to maintain operations or reopen after the disaster
- You must be a sole operator – no employees

Apply for TSB Status by April 10th, 2020



TSB Eligibility Requirements

- To be eligible for TSB Certification, businesses must be:
- Located in the state of Iowa; and
- Operating for a profit; and
- Make less than \$4 million in gross income, computed as an average of the preceding three fiscal years; and
- Majority owned (51% or more), operated and managed by a female, individual with minority status, service disabled veteran or individual with a disability
- The funds may not be used to pay debts incurred prior to March 17, 2020.



SBA Federal Disaster Loan Program for small businesses

- What is it?
- Who is eligible to apply?
- How do I apply & what do I need to apply?
- Will this change with new legislation?
 - Should I wait until new legislation passes?



What do I need to apply?

(most of these forms are available online)

- Last three years of federal tax returns for your business (can have transcripts sent)
- Last three years of personal federal tax returns (can have transcripts sent)
- Schedule of Liabilities
- A Personal Financial Statement
- Articles of Incorporation
- A business plan with cash-flow projections might be helpful, but probably not required
